



## **Sample Interview Protocol**

These questions can be used or adapted to your school's needs in order to assess a candidate's writing expertise.

- 1. What do you think is the value of formal writing? Of informal writing?
  - a. Can you provide an example of how you use informal writing to help students learn?
  - c. How do you help students create connections between formal and informal writing?
- 2. Can you provide an example of how you teach students to connect in-class reading to their writing assignments?
- 3. How would describe your understanding of writing processes?
  - a. How do your assignments help students generate ideas for their papers?
  - b. Can you provide an example of how your assignments help students move from ideas to drafts?
  - c. How do your assignments encourage students to revise and edit?
- 4. In addition to essays, what genres and modes of writing do you encourage your students to use? What genres do you use for informal, low-stakes writing? What genres do you use for formal, graded assignments?
- 5. How do you integrate technology into your teaching? How do you connect traditional print writing assignments to new media writing forms?
- 6. How do you explain assessment processes and link those assessment processes to further growth?
  - a. How do you distinguish between summative and formative evaluation?
  - b. What relationship do you see between assessment and instruction?
  - c. What is the role of high stakes testing in the teaching of writing?
