

TEACHER TO TEACHER RESOURCE: SHARED READING

1. Provide a text such as a short story, which all students will read together.
2. Support the choral or silent reading with your own voice as necessary.
3. Return to the text to do one of the following:
 - Re-read
 - Demonstrate reading strategy
 - Teach sound, word, or grammar features
4. Provide copies of the text for students to read independently.

Examples of texts to use for shared reading:

- Big book
- Poem projected on a screen
- Individual copies of a short story
- Individual copies of the same book
